

THEATRE APPRECIATION –ANTI PLAGIARISM AGREEMENT

DEFINITION:

Plagiarism- “pla·gia·rism,” *noun*. The practice of taking someone else’s writing, work, images, or ideas and passing them off as your own.

In DRM 1310, Plagiarism will **not** be tolerated. The act of plagiarism is grounds for academic discipline and dismissal from the course.

THE AGREEMENT:

I understand and agree that plagiarism is defined as above.

I understand that using someone else’s work as my own is **Active Plagiarism** and is grounds for disciplinary action, including dismissal from the course.

I understand that giving or sharing my work with a classmate to use as their own, is **Passive Plagiarism** and is grounds for disciplinary action including dismissal from the course.

I understand that plagiarism is considered **academic theft** and is wrong in all academic settings, including this course.

I agree that **using another person’s written words, ideas, drawings, designs and any other artistic endeavors as my own** is plagiarism and will not be tolerated in this course.

I understand that any student caught plagiarizing in this course **may face any and all of the following consequences:**

- Be given a zero** for the assignment.
- Be subject to further disciplinary action.**
- Have the **plagiarized material documented and placed in the student’s academic record.**
- Require the offender to attend a **Conduct Meeting with ACC College staff.**
- Subject the student to **dismissal from the course.**
- Subject the student to **dismissal from ACC.**
